
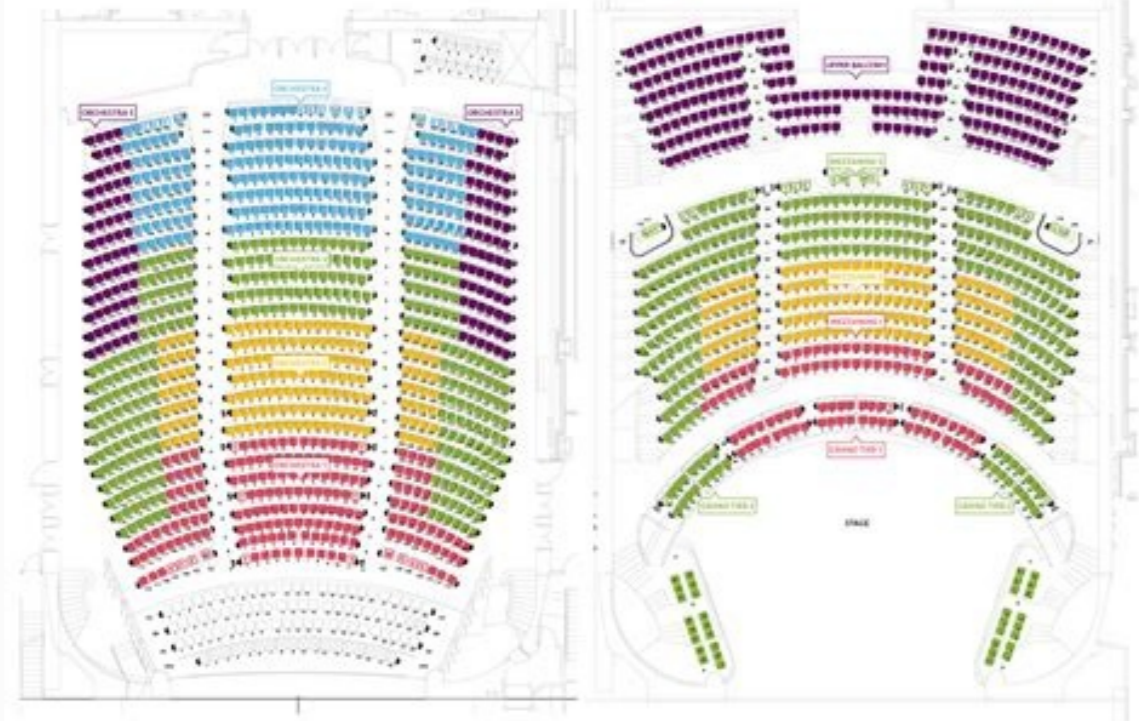

Capitol theatre seating chart sydney

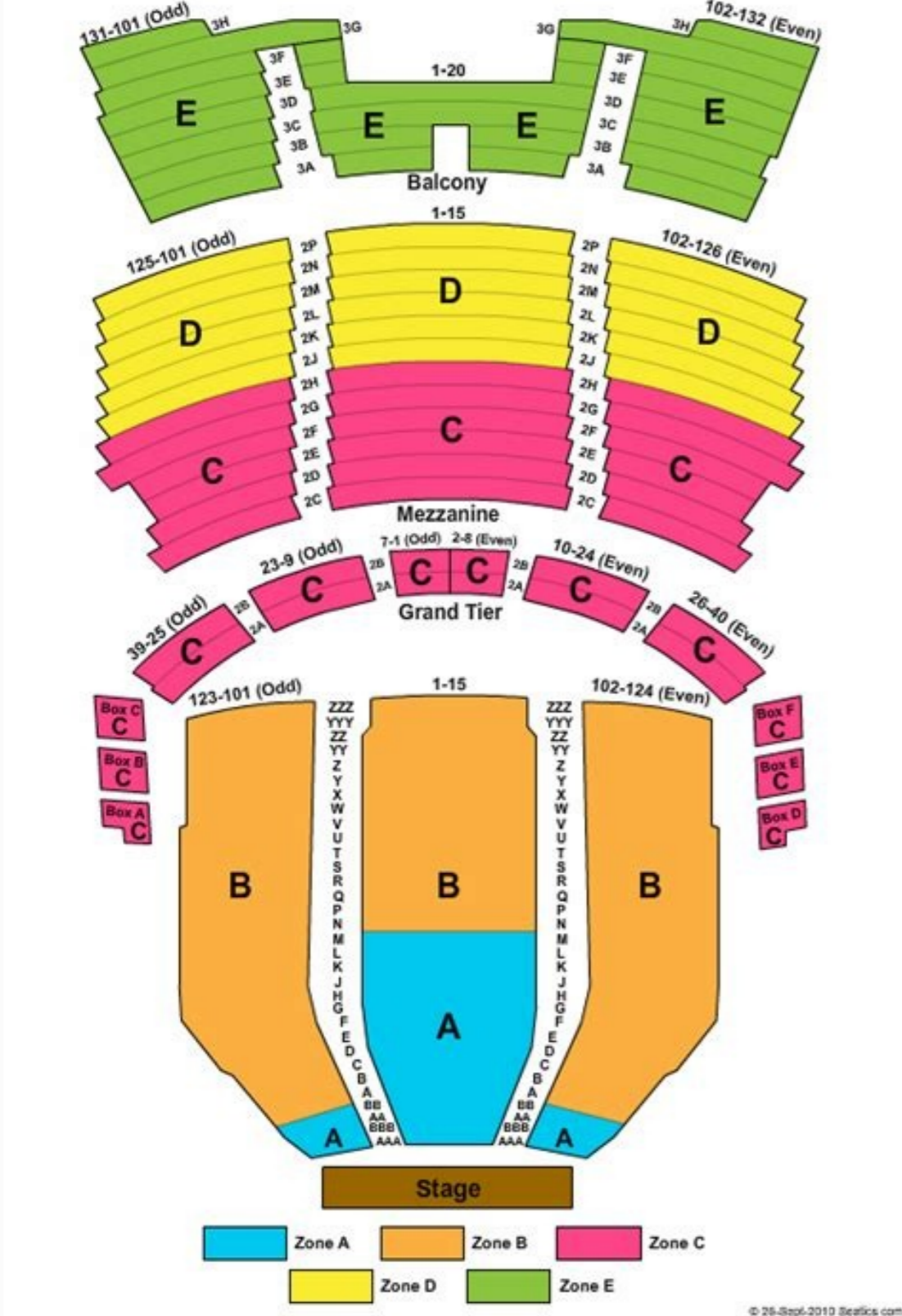
Top Stalls is located on the ground level (same level as the Stage). Stalls seating starts to gradually incline from Row B right to the back of the Stalls. Patrons will be at eye level with the Stage at around Row E-G. The front of the Stalls offers a close-up experience. View Larger Seating Plan Click for Virtual Tour of the Stalls Dress Circle seating is located 1 level above the stage, the centre of the front row (Row A) of the Dress Circle is approximately 16.5 metres away from the stage, it sits in line with Stalls Row K. Please note, there is a safety rail installed in front row and box seats that might inhibit the view of some people. Dress Circle row A also has slightly less leg room compared to other seating in our auditorium. View Larger Seating Plan Click for Virtual Tour of the Dress Circle Hearing Loop is available in the Stalls and Dress Circle. Please note, only highlighted seats have hearing loop reception. Patrons should adjust their hearing aids to "T" for reception. If you are unable to access the hearing loop, the theatre can also provide you with an "Intelligent DSP RF Receiver (150MHz)" which you can wear around your neck for the duration of the performance. The RF Receiver works in all theatre seats. You can adjust your hearing aid to "T" for reception or if this is not possible, we can also provide you with a headset to plug into that device. Please note, we have limited devices available, however will do our best to assist you on your visit. Visit Ticketmaster For in person bookings, you can visit our Box Office from Monday-Friday, 9am-5pm. Our Box Office is also open from 11am on Saturday & Sunday (when performances are scheduled). Box Office cannot assist with general ticket sales from 1.5 hours prior to any performance time and does not usually operate on Public Holidays. View seating plans. Mobile Delivery ticketing is like Print-at-Home tickets but instead of having to print off the tickets yourself, you can just show the ticket barcode on your mobile phone. If you have a mobile ticket, make sure you have your ticket ready on your phone, with the QR bar code clearly visible for scanning at the auditorium doors. To access your mobile ticket, log into your Ticketmaster account from your phone. Please make sure your phone is fully charged and have screen brightness set to full so your ticket can be scanned. If you are unable to do that, don't worry, we can try scan them from your phone, and if that doesn't work, our Box Office will be able to re-print them for you. 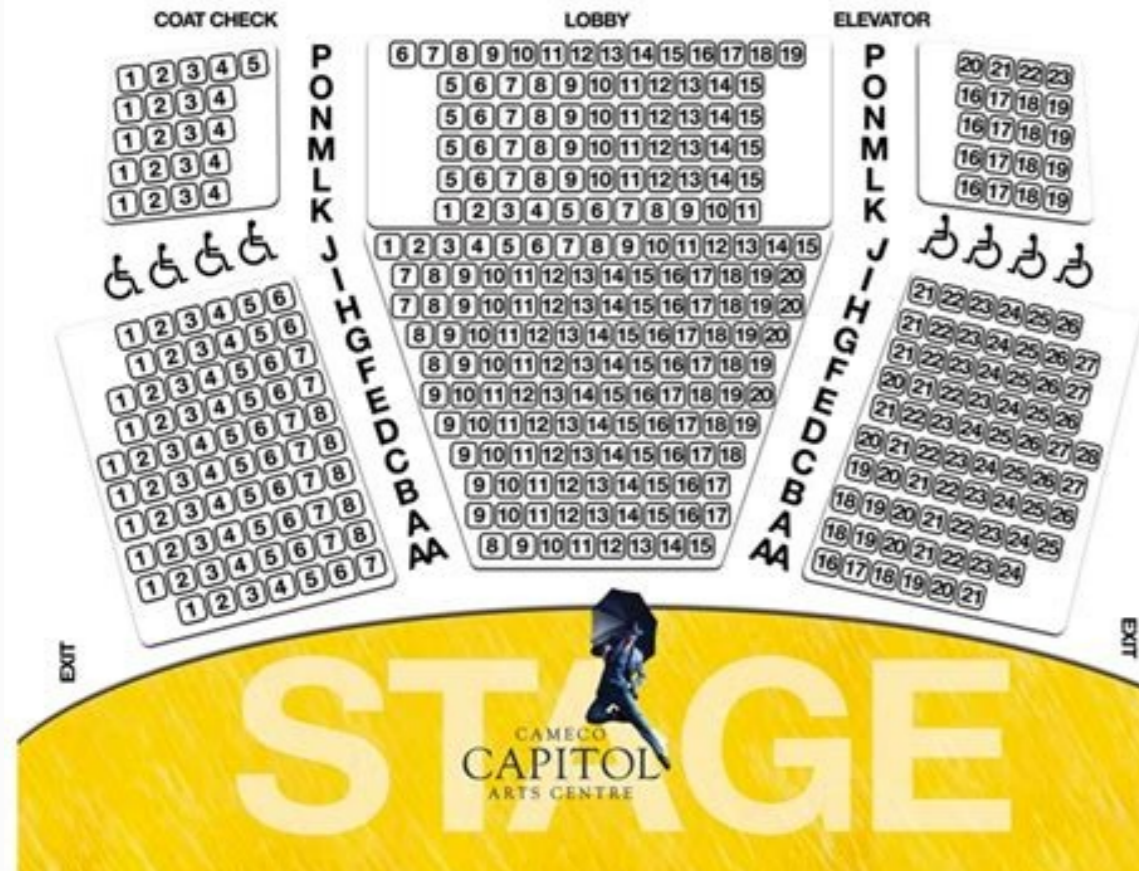

How far back can you sit and still make out an actor's facial expressions? Will you end up with neck cramp if you sit in row B? Just how restricted is that 'restricted view' seat on the side? Will you feel like you're in another postcode if you can only afford the back row? What even is the difference between the stalls and circle? (Hint: Stalls are always downstairs - the upstairs balconies in a theatre are called the circle or the mezzanine). Our editors have spent thousands of hours sitting and awing at dramas and comedies and one-woman experimental monologues, so along the way we've gathered plenty of intel on exactly where you want to be in Sydney's theatres. 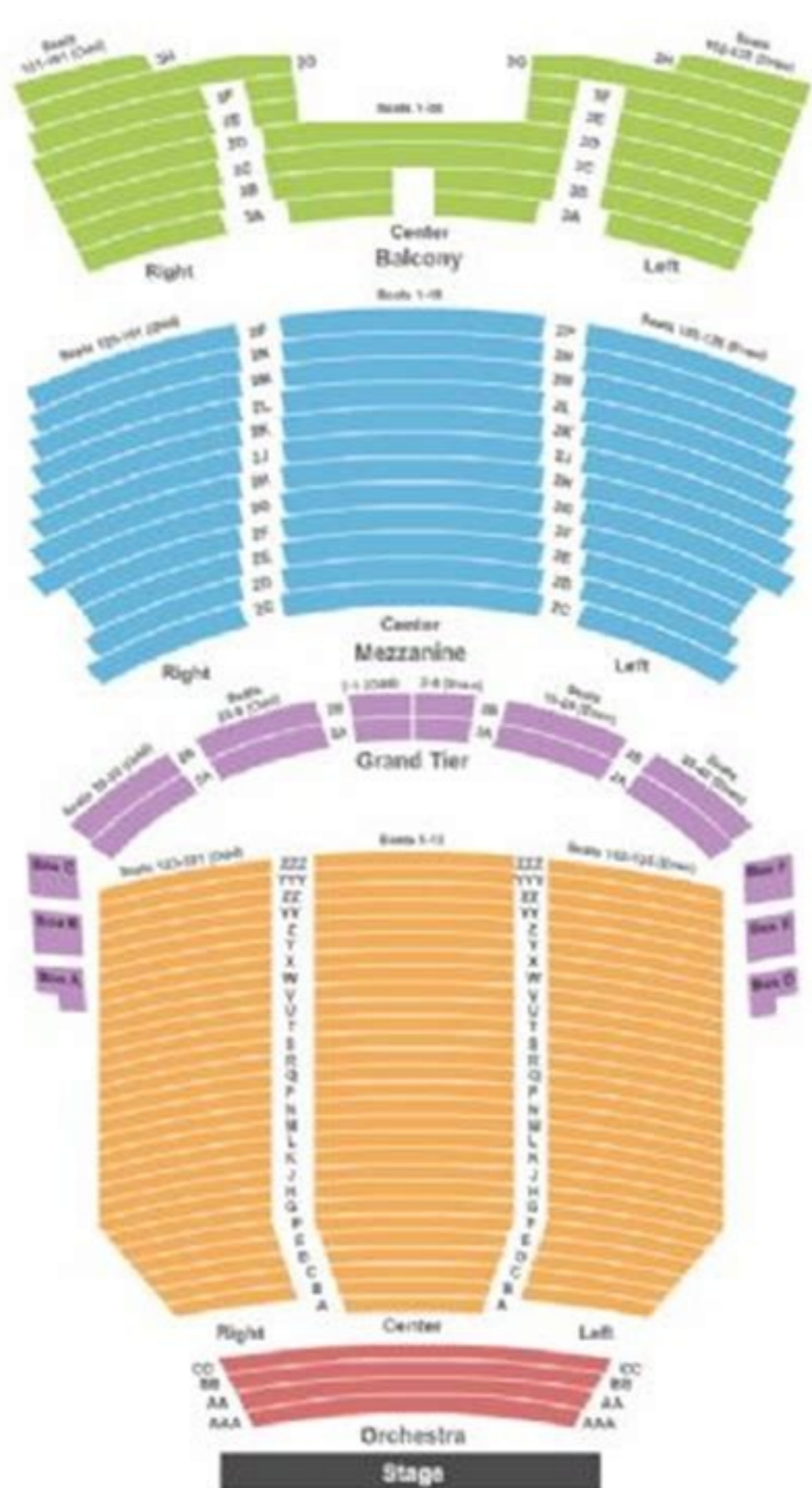

Wheelchair and Transfer Seating Stalls Row WW is a raised platform section reserved for wheelchair bookings. It offers good views of the stage and can accommodate a companion. If you are able to transfer from a wheelchair/mobility scooter into a theatre seat you may wish to book an aisle seat in the Stalls. Our ushers will assist by storing your wheelchair and bringing it to you at interval and the end of the show. Wheelchair and mobility scooter access is easily available in the Stalls and very limited in the Dress Circle. If your question is not answered here please email access@foundationtheatres.com.au. Limited Mobility or Trouble with Stairs If you have trouble negotiating stairs, please book your seats in the Stalls. There is ramp access available via Door 2 or Doors 3-5 only have approx. 4 steps (with access to a handrail). See our Stalls seating map here. There are also select seats in the Dress Circle with minimal stairs located near Door 6, if you have tickets near Door 6, you should see an usher before the show for access. Please note, most of the seats in the Dress Circle have many stairs to negotiate, see Dress Circle map here.

Wheelchair Bookings Stalls Row WW is a raised platform section reserved for wheelchair bookings. These seats can be booked by emailing us to request a call back. Our Box Office will call you to complete your booking as soon as possible, between the hours of Monday-Friday, 9am-5pm. Companion Card Bookings Companion Card holders can book by emailing us to request a call back. Our Box Office will call you to complete your booking as soon as possible, between the hours of Monday-Friday, 9am-5pm. If you are wanting to make a last minute on the day booking for a Saturday or Sunday performance, please check ticket availability online and purchase in person at our box office before the show. *Companion card bookings are not available on packaged seats.



Theatre Info Accessible toilets are located on both the Stalls and Dress Circle levels. Hearing Loop is available in the Stalls and Dress Circle. Please note, only highlighted seats have hearing loop reception. View hearing loop map.



Patrons should adjust their hearing aids to "T" for reception. If you are unable to access the hearing loop, the theatre can also provide you with an "Intelligent DSP RF Receiver (150MHZ)" which you can wear around your neck for the duration of the performance. The RF Receiver works in all theatre seats. You can adjust your hearing aid to "T" for reception or if this is not possible, we can also provide you with a headset to plug into that device. Please note, we have limited devices available, however will do our best to assist you on your visit. Accredited service dogs are allowed to enter the theatre upon presentation of accreditation proof. Service dogs must remain on the floor at all times. Virtual Tour Our virtual tour lets you walk through our auditorium before you come for your visit. This shows you what the theatre looks like without a production on stage. When you arrive, the production's set, lighting and sound equipment will help bring the theatre to life. For patrons with a visual impairment the distance between the centre seat in the specified row and the stage, measured from safety curtain, is: Stalls, Row AA - approximately 6 metres; Stalls, Row D - approximately 12 metres; Stalls, Row H - approximately 16 metres; Dress Circle, Row A - approximately 19.5 metres. Stalls seating starts to gradually incline from Row B right to the back of the Stalls. Patrons will be at eye level with the Stage at around Row E-G. View the Capitol Theatre seating plan. Our seat cushions are 420x420mm with armrests that are 520mm in length. Seats without arms can be booked if required for accessibility via our Box Office.
